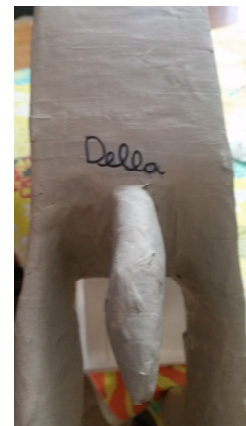


## Gazelle, Part 4 – Customize

1. Once the paint is completely dry, you can add your own special flair! The picture to the left has designs based on African symbols. My 7-year granddaughter did these!!
2. I suggest you put your designs on paper first, then pencil them onto the sides. (Be sure and do both sides!)
3. Trace over the penciled designs with the marker.

1. Now you're ready to add some details...antler stripes, eyes, inner ear and hooves
2. Refer to the pictures and pencil in the details.
3. Using the dark brown paint and a small brush, paint in the details.
